Mathematics

Whole Number

- Count forward to 30 from a given number
- Count backwards from a given number in the range 0-30
- Read and use the ordinal names to at least 'tenth'
- Use the language of money

Addition & Subtraction

- Record addition and subtraction informally using drawings, words or numerals
- Combine two or more groups of objects
- Compare groups to determine 'how many more?'
- Take part of a group away to model subtraction
- Show combinations to 20

Multiplication and Division

- Investigate and model equal groups
- Record grouping and sharing using informal methods

Area

- Identify the attribute of 'area'
- Describe area using comparative language
- Compare area using direct comparison
- Record comparisons of area informally
