Stage 1 Overview Term 1 2023

English

Literacy

Students participate in explicit reading and writing lessons in small groups designed to meet their specific learning needs. They also engage in independent, individual or group tasks to practise and consolidate their current literacy learning.

Oral language and communication

Students communicate effectively by using interpersonal conventions to extend and elaborate ideas for social and learning interactions.

Road Safety

Students will learn to identify safe behaviours and actions when using forms of transport as well as pedestrian safety.



Fitness & Sport

- Students will practise and develop specific fundamental movement skills (FMS) while participating in individual/group/team physical activities.
- Students will practise dance movements for the Easter Hat Parade.

- Use counting sequences of ones with two-digit numbers and beyond
