Arabic:

Mathematics

Whole Numbers

- Numbers to 30
- Identify number before and after
- Subitising small collections of objects
- Ordinals 1st to 10th

Addition & Subtraction

- Combine two or more groups of objects
- Use concrete materials or fingers to model and solve simple addition and subtraction problems
- Describe the action of combining, separating and comparing using everyday language
- Count forwards and backwards by ones to add and subtract
- Record addition and subtraction informally using drawings, or numerals

Mass

- Use everyday language to describe objects in terms of their mass
- Use comparative language to describe mass
- Compare two masses directly by hefting
- Record comparisons of mass informally using drawings, numerals and words

3D Space

- Recognise and use informal names for three-dimensional objects

- Use everyday language to describe internal volumes of containers by directly filling and pouring
