All invitation letters to Presentation Day were sent out to award recipients this week. Please ensure you return the acceptance letter before next **Tuesday 1 December.**

Remember the coloured COVID form that was sent out with the invitation letter must be filled in and brought in on the day.

Answers to frequently asked questions:

- **We are sorry, but there is no waitlist for extra parents that want to attend. The limit of 1 parent per child applies regardless.**
- Unfortunately we cannot accommodate toddlers and babies.
- The assembly will not be live streamed.
- Parents are asked to arrive 10 minutes prior to the commencement of the Assembly. Logistics will prevent admission of late arrivals.
- Parents will be admitted into the school from the Avenal St gate entrance and will be crossed checked on the invitation list and the signed COVID Declaration Form collected by Staff. Parents will then be required to go directly to the Hall/COLA where they are to remain seated throughout the event.
- Exiting the school will promptly follow the conclusion of the event via the school gate at the side of the School Hall. Parents are asked to refrain from mingling.

As a reminder, the Presentation Day Assembly will be held over 3 days as follows:

- **S1 Tuesday 8th Dec from 10:15 am**
- **S2 Wednesday 9th Dec from 9:15 am**

A booklet will be prepared for our Presentation Assemblies with all award recipients K-6 listed. This will be sent home on Thursday 10th December with the eldest child from each family.

Our School Captains will host the ES1, Stage 1 and Stage 2 assembly. Prefects and Captains will host the Stage 3 assembly. The 2021 School Captains and Prefects will be announced at the Stage 3 assembly.

We will listen to the National Anthem, but refrain from singing it. The 2020 Captains and Prefects will perform their dance item at each assembly.
