Strike information



27 April 2022

Dear parents and carers

The department has been negotiating with the NSW Teachers Federation since October last year to reach an agreement on the new Teachers Award.

The NSW Teachers Federation has directed its membership to take industrial action in the form of a 24-hour strike on **Wednesday 4 May 2022**.

As a result of the strike, your school may only be providing minimal student supervision on this date. Minimal supervision means onsite teaching and learning continues, however temporary class structures and a modified timetable are required to meet safety and supervision requirements. Your principal will be in contact by early next week to notify you about arrangements at your school.

The department is seeking a resolution for a new 3-year Teachers Award through arbitration in the Industrial Relations Commission in early May.

Your principal will keep you informed with any further updates for your school for next Wednesday 4 May.

COVID-19 UPDATE

From the Department of Education

Our priorities in Term 2 remain the same - to maintain student learning in classrooms wherever possible, while ensuring the wellbeing of our students and staff. There are some adjustments to operations to maintain consistency with community settings as we enter the next phase of the pandemic.

Changes to isolation for close contacts

The announcement to <u>ease the isolation requirements for close contacts</u> will enable students and staff who are close contacts and have no symptoms to continue to attend school if they follow NSW Health guidelines, including daily rapid antigen testing and wearing a mask indoors (for all staff and secondary students).

For more information about students and staff who return to school as a close contact, refer to close contact guidelines.

NSW Health has updated the advice for students and staff returning to school after testing positive for COVID-19 including the recommendation to wear a mask for an additional 3 days after the 7-day isolation period.

Additional supplies of RAT kits will be distributed to all schools to support staff and students identified as close contacts who are able to return.
