



Speaking and Listening - Studerist use communication skills such its questioning and parachisesing, participating and contributing to discussions, clarifying ideas, developing sharing and evaluating information. Students will also participate writing a speech for the Multicultural Publist Speaking Competition, Reading and Verbing - Students develop guized, upled, modelled and independent reading skills using both factor and factual tests. One reading and comprehension acts tiles using stocks, novels and articles.
