# Pay online before 6pm

There has been some confusion regarding online payments which we hope to clarify.

If you make a payment **before 6pm**, we will be notified of your payment the following day and it will be processed in our system.

If you make a payment **after 6pm**, we will not receive notification of the payment until 2 days later.

Therefore, if we send out payment reminders via the App or via School Bytes, please ignore this if you paid within the above windows.

If you plan to leave your payment until the day before it is due, it would be really helpful if you could please make the payment before 6pm to ensure your payment is processed by the due date and your child will be able to attend the excursion.

It would also be helpful if you could complete the online permission slip and make the payment **at the same time**. Some families are completing the permission slip but not making payment until many days later, and this is causing some confusion.
