Well done Archie!



High School Information




Stay alert for COVID

Students will be sent home if they present with any of the following symptoms:

- Coughing
- Nasal congestion
- Runny nose
- Fevers
- Sore throat
- Gastrointestinal symptoms
- Muscle/joint pain

We adhere to NSW Health guidelines and continue to remind the School community to be vigilant. Close contacts can still attend school but must:

- Notify the school they are a close contact
- Conduct a daily RAT and return a negative result each morning before attending school for five school days.
- Staff and students are not to attend school if they are displaying any symptoms (even if mild). If a student or staff member becomes unwell they must test for COVID with PCR or RAT.
- The staff/student should still not return to school until ALL symptoms have resolved or unless they provide a valid medical certificate confirming symptoms are explained by another diagnosis (eg: hayfever).
