Ethics classes support children to develop the skills they need to voice their opinions, consider the ideas of others and to make decisions based on evidence and reasoning rather than habit or peer pressure.

Ethics classes are facilitated by impartial ethics teachers who are trained to deliver our Dept approved curriculum.

**Volunteers are needed now** to teach ethics at Arncliffe PS. Classes run for 30 mins on Fridays at 12pm each week. Full training and scripts are provided and you only need about an hour a week.
