They get 1/2 of the learning opportunities

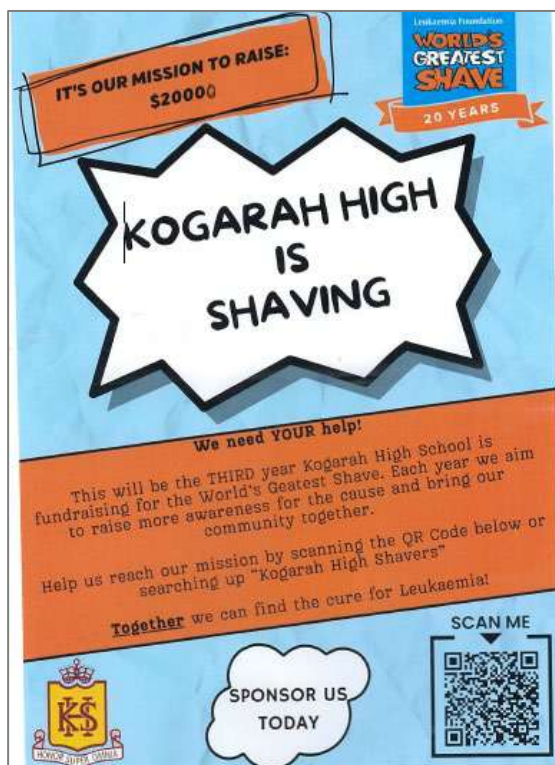
3/4 of the time
