Our P&C have organized a wonderful selection of gifts for children to purchase for their Dads, Grandads, Carer Dads in celebration of Father's Day.



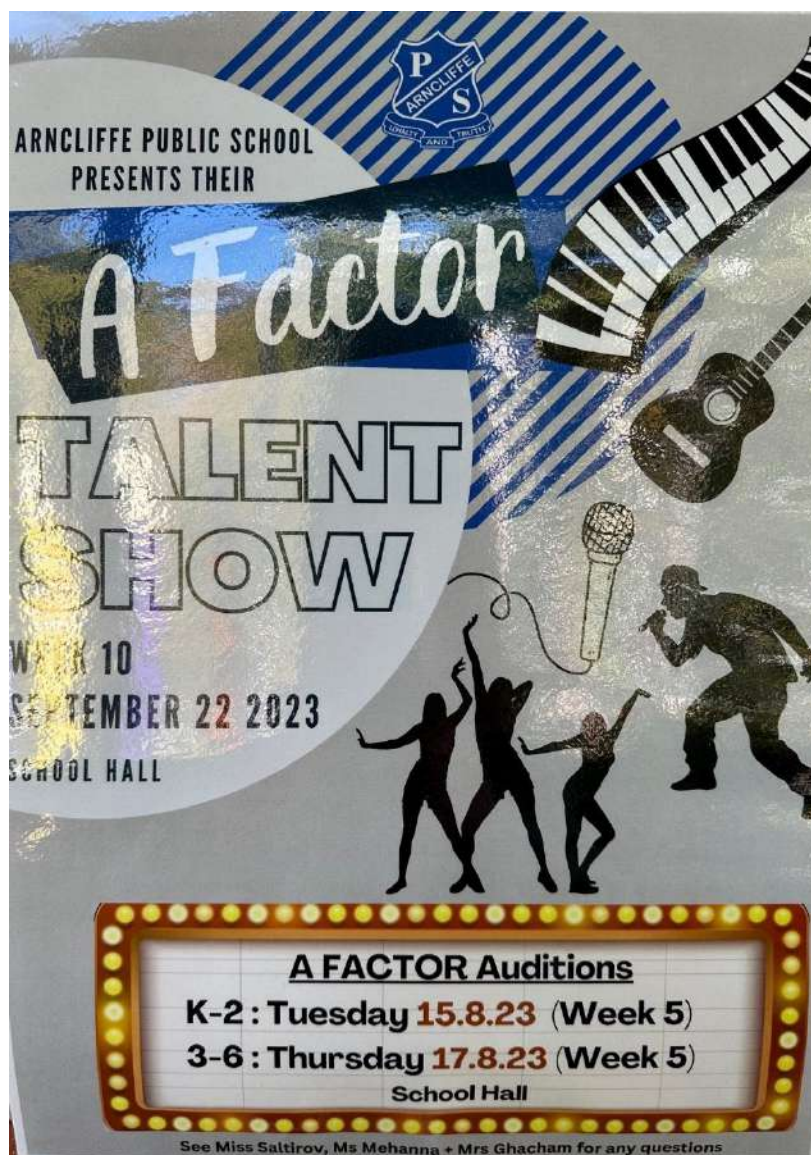

Tell Them From Me student survey

This term, our school is taking part in the Tell Them From Me student survey. The survey will provide us with valuable feedback on what our students think about school life, how engaged they are with school and the different ways that teachers interact with them.

The survey is run by an independent research company, The Learning Bar, which specialises in school-based surveys.

This survey is confidential, and staff in schools will not be able to identify individual students from their responses.

To ensure confidentiality, participating students will receive a unique username and password. Information is only reported where five or more students answer a question.

The survey is online, takes 15 to 30 minutes, and will take place at school during school hours. We will receive a report on our school's survey results shortly after our students complete the survey.

Participating in the survey is voluntary. If any survey questions make your child uncomfortable, your child can skip the question or can choose to stop the survey at any time.

You will shortly receive an email regarding this. If you do not want your child/children in Years 4.5 and 6 to take part in the survey, you will need to print and complete the form attached to the email and return it to the school by Friday 8 September 2023.
