School intake area adjustments - Community feedback

Thank you to everyone who provided feedback in the community consultation about the proposed changes to school intake areas. We want to share with you some information on changes that will increase access to coeducational settings for more families in our local area and surrounds.

The NSW Government has committed to offering every student a guaranteed option to enrol in a designated co-educational high school by 2027. Enrolments will open in 2024 for students to commence in Term 1, 2025.

The department webpage has links to interactive maps to help you identify the guaranteed coeducational option for your home address.

If your home is currently in an intake area for a single-sex school you will still be able to enrol at that school. The proposed coeducational option for your home address will be an <u>additional</u> option for you.

You can view the finalised school intake areas on the <u>department website</u>, so you can see which high schools your child is able to attend in Term 1, 2025. The finalised school intake areas will also be made available on School Finder in Term 1, 2024.

Our school staff are available to talk through high school options and these changes with you. We will also continue to support your child, so they can understand the options available to them. If you have further questions, do not hesitate to contact us via email or visit the department website.
