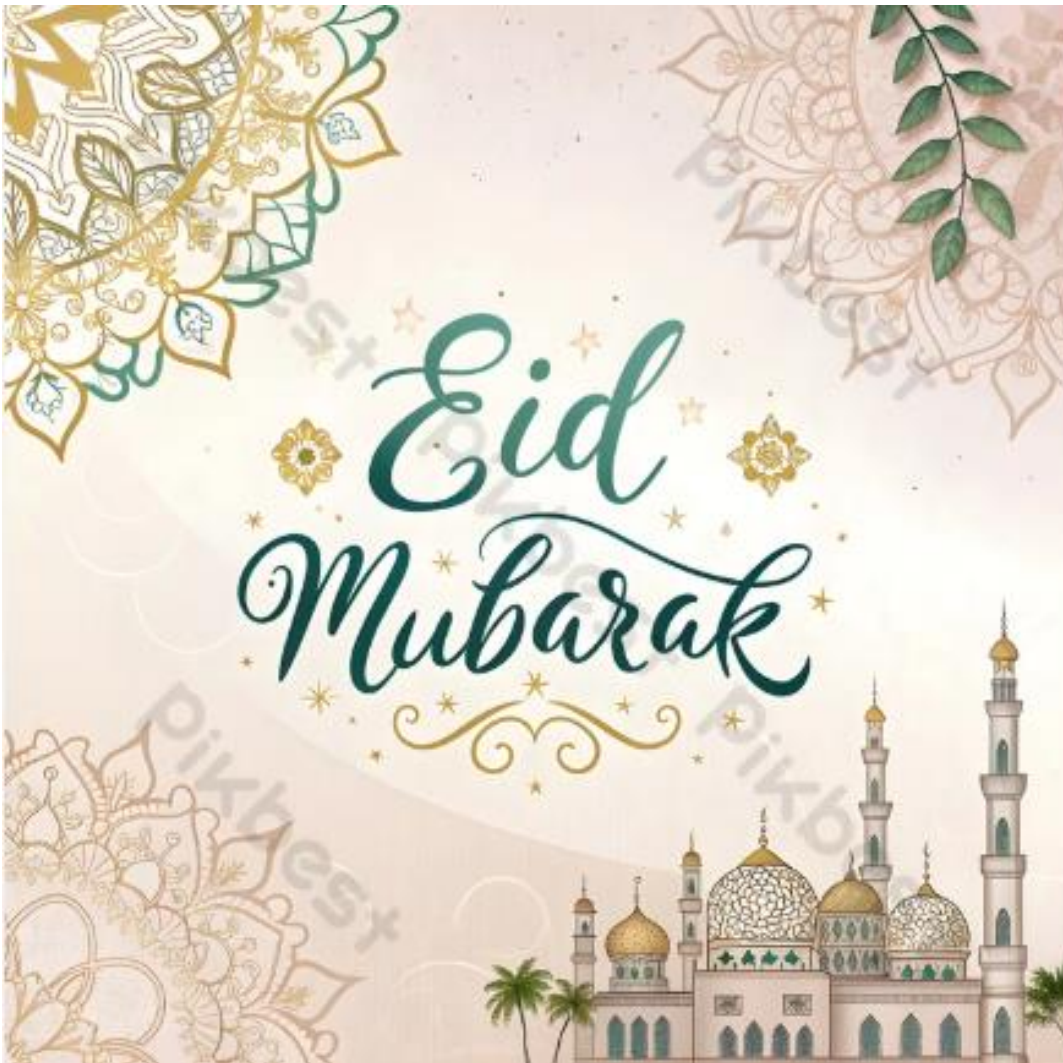

MSC: How to Top Up/Auto Top Up

**HOW TO...  
TOP UP AND AUTO TOP UP**

**Step 1:**

- Open up the My School Connect webpage <https://myschoolconnect.com.au/> and login in.
- Once logged in, click **<Top up and Financial History>**



**Step 2:**

- Click **<Top up>**




MSC: How to Top Up/Auto Top Up

**AUTO TOP UP**


**Step 5:**

- There is another option to use 'Auto top up'
- This option will automatically top up your account when the account reaches a minimum limit (which you set)
- To activate this option click **<Auto top up>**



**Step 6:**


- Select your Auto Top Up payment method: Credit card; or Paypal
- Provide payment details as required for the payment method selected
- Set your account limits:
  - Minimum balance (at which point the account will auto top up); and
  - Auto top up amount (the payment you wish to make for each Auto top up)
- Click **<Save>**
- Note: you can return to this page to update/change your Auto Top Up settings at any time.



MSC: How to Top Up/Auto Top Up


**Step 3:**

- Select your method of payment: Bank account (EFT); Credit Card; or Paypal
- Select amount you wish to Top up: \$25; \$50; \$100; Other
- Follow prompted steps to complete payment depending on method of payment selected (see 3A for further detail)



**Step 3A – payment method:**

- Follow prompted steps to complete payment depending on method of payment selected
- IF paying by Bank Account:** select amount and click **<I want to pay via internet banking. Show me your BSB and account details>**
  - Transfer funds through your bank provider into the BSB / Account details and include the **REFERENCE NUMBER** provided
  - Click **<Confirm notification>** once you have completed your electronic funds transfer (EFT)
- IF paying by Credit card:** form will automatically appear to enter card details for payment
- IF paying by Paypal:** you'll be taken to the Paypal website to complete your payment.

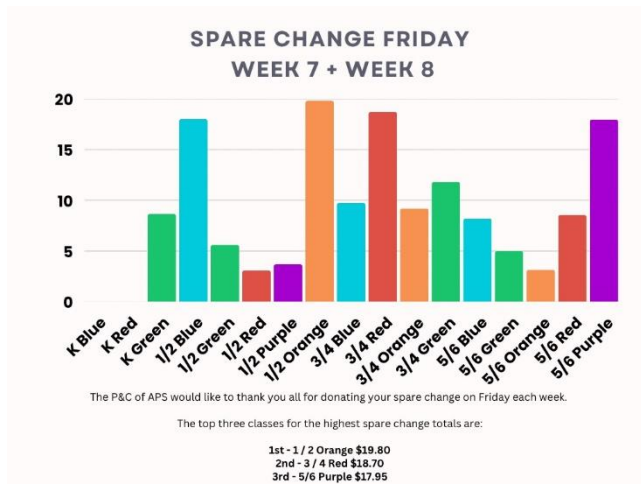
