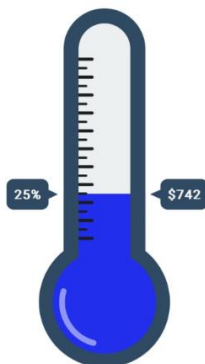




## Spare coin Thursday
