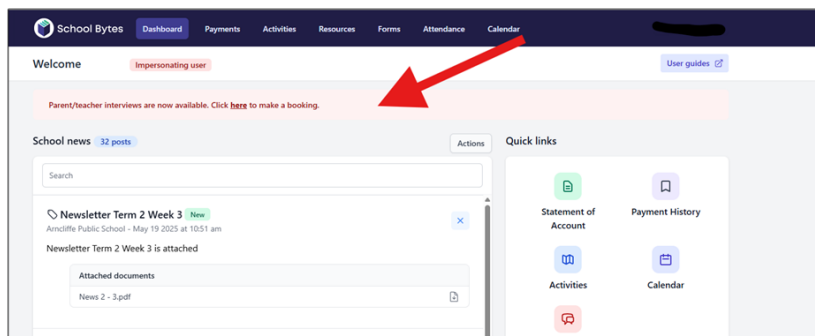

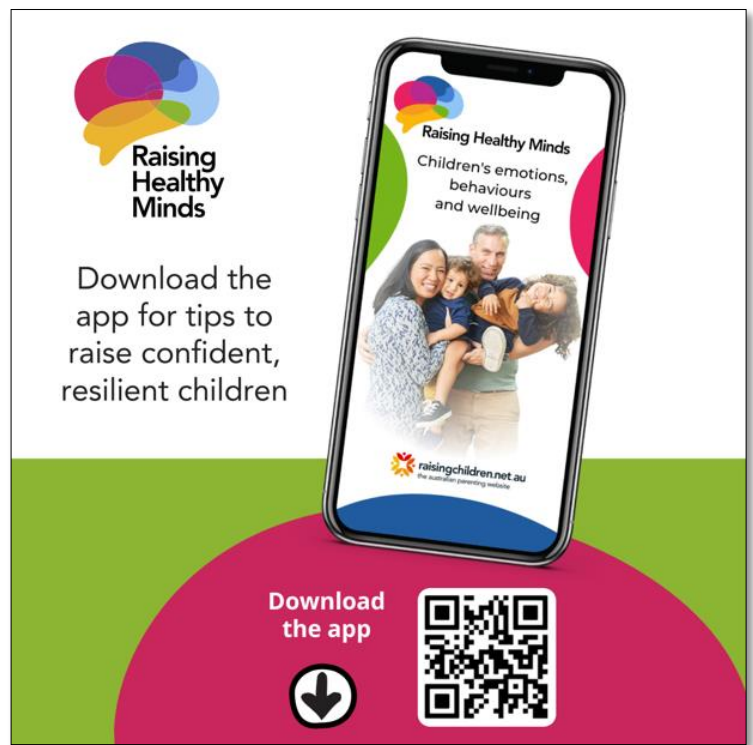
## KINDERGARTEN ENROLING NOW
